

Brisa Consortium obtains the provisional award of the Poceirão-Caia High Speed Rail stretch

BRISA – Auto-estradas de Portugal S.A. (“Brisa”) hereby informs that its jointly led consortium (“ELOS”) received in a public ceremony, which took place last December 12th, the decision regarding the provisional award of the Poceirão-Caia High Speed Rail Concession.

ELOS consortium is made up of the following companies: Brisa 16.3%; Soares da Costa 16.3%; Iridium 15.2%; Lena 13.0%; Odebrecht 13.0%; Edifer 7.6%; Zagope 7.6%; Caixa Geral de Depósitos 5%; Millennium BCP 5%.

The Concession will include the construction and maintenance of the infrastructure, not including the train operations. It will be granted for a 40 year period and, according to the submitted proposal, it will comprise a total investment close to 1 650 million Euros.
