- Develop business solutions that promote sustainable mobility and that generally respond to the challenges and opportunities of a low carbon economy;
- Clearly define the responsibilities of employees, guarantee their training and implement the means and processes necessary to achieve objectives;
- Promote the integration of the group's activities in the circular economy, as a path to sustainable use of resources and to the progressive reduction of waste;
- Take an active role in protecting ecosystems and biodiversity and promoting their respective valuation, in the current processes of the group and through the promotion and management of natural heritage, based on partnerships;
